PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Parishioners,

I hope everyone enjoyed the start of the new year and that God blesses you and yours with peace and prosperity & health and happiness this year.

I will be departing later this week for my retreat. The Church wisely requires a priest to take a five-day canonical retreat yearly to ensure that he has time to strengthen his personal relationship with God through time away from the demands of pastoral life. The others will take their retreats at various times during the year as well. A retreat is a great gift and privilege and I am grateful that I can take mine at this moment when things are, for the most part, quiet after the Christmas festivities.

While I am away the Church of Saint Rocco will mark eighty years as a parish. Bishop Molloy canonically erected our parish on January 18, 1937. I invite everyone to mark this anniversary with your participation in the Parish Pastoral Plan. The first meeting to organize committees to achieve the goals from the five pillars of the plan will take place on Thursday, January 19th at 7:30 pm. Please come and volunteer! Our parish needs everyone!

The following Friday, January 27th, is the annual March for Life in Washington, DC. The largest, oldest and most important pro-life demonstration in the world will benefit you and your family! Please consider coming. It is a long day, but is it also a worthwhile sacrifice. Free transportation is provided from the St Patrick parking. Mass will be celebrated at 5:00 am at St Patrick before the departure at 5:45 am. As this is such an important event of bearing witness to human dignity, all the priests will be away that day. **Consequently, the only Mass at St Rocco or St Patrick will be the one Mass at 5 am.**

Additionally, this year, the Bishop of the Byzantine Catholic Eparchy of Passaic, the Most Reverend Kurt Burnett, has invited me to preach at Night Prayer at the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception at 10 pm on January 26th. I suspect it might be televised on ETWN or Telecare; please consult their websites for programming information.

We are hoping for a good turnout this year and have made special efforts to invite the older students from All Saints. Families of public school children are of course also invited as long as an adult chaperone (parent or another trusted family member) accompanies your children. If you want to come by bus, please contact Kelsey McManus at the parish office or parish email. She is the coordinator and can answer any of your questions.

Finally, at the end of January, we celebrate Catholic Schools Week, starting on Sunday, January 29th, with an Open House, 10:00 am - 1:00 pm. I have great expectations for the school and look forward to seeing them come to fruition. We expect major investments to improve and transform the school in the coming year. I look forward to giving more details soon. I hope we will see more children from St Rocco next year. The sacrifices to afford a Catholic education are worth it.

Please remember to say a prayer for me during my retreat and I will be praying for you too!

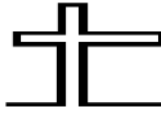
Message from Pastor

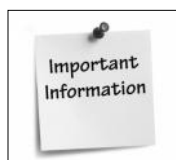

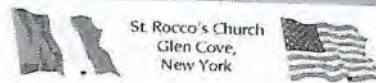
