



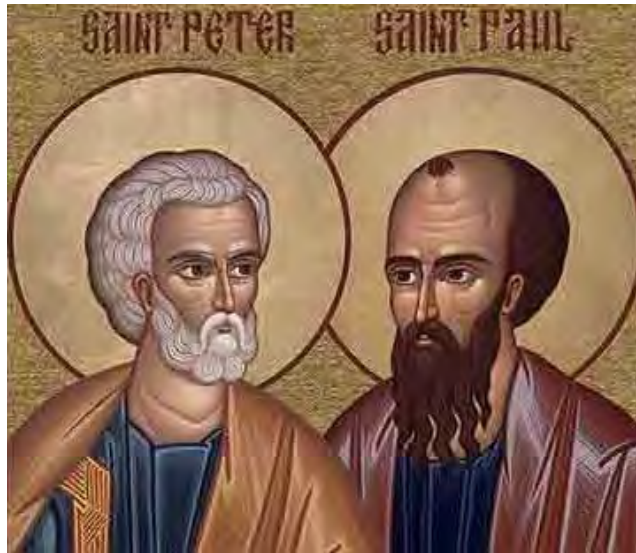

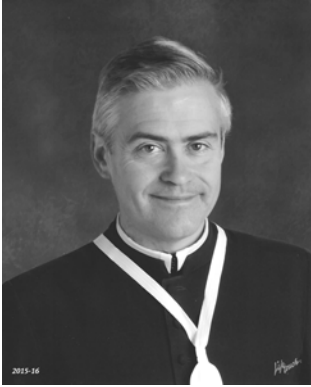

June 29th - The Solemnity of Saint Peter and Paul

“Veneration of the two great Apostles, Peter and Paul, has its roots in the very foundations of the Church. They are the solid rock on which the Church is built. They are at the origin of her faith and will forever remain her protectors and her guides. To them Rome owes her true greatness, for it was under God's providential guidance that they were led to make the capital of the Empire, sanctified by their martyrdom, the center of the Christian world whence should radiate the preaching of the Gospel.” - from catholicculture.org.

Saint Peter suffered martyrdom under Nero, in A.D. 66 or 67. He was buried on the hill of the Vatican where recent excavations have revealed his tomb on the very site of the Basilica of St. Peter's. St. Paul was beheaded outside the city wall, near the spot where a basilica now stands in his name. Since the time of their martyrdom, Christians have been making pilgrimages to these sites. *Saints Peter and Paul, pray for us!*

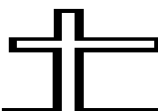
