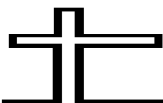

*Bible Study starts Tuesday, September 12th!*

*Join us Tuesday nights from 7:30-8:30pm*

*This year's topic is the Gospel of Matthew*

We are planning 32 sessions beginning Sept. 12 and running through June 2018 to investigate the Gospel according to Saint Matthew, one chapter per week. Father Daniel will start with an introduction on September 12th and then we will start with Chapter 1 the following week. A full schedule with meeting dates will be provided at the first meeting. Bring your bible and a few friends!

The Gospel of Matthew is the first book of the New Testament and also the most quoted Gospel in noncanonical literature of early Christianity. This Gospel follows the key events in the life of Christ and incorporates His key teachings. The Gospel includes unique elements and some of the most famous accounts not found in other Gospels including the story of the Wise Men visiting Christ after His Nativity, the flight of the Holy Family into Egypt, the "Sermon on the Mount" in which we are given the Beatitudes, and many of the parables about the kingdom of heaven. Tradition holds that it was written by an eye-witness, the apostle and tax-collector, Matthew, who walked with Jesus and heard his teaching. Its authority ultimately comes from the truth that it is the inspired Word of God. Through it, God has chosen to reveal Himself to us in unique ways. You can experience the beauty of this revelation by delving into this text with other Christians under the instruction of the Canons of St. Patrick's and St. Rocco's. All are welcome!

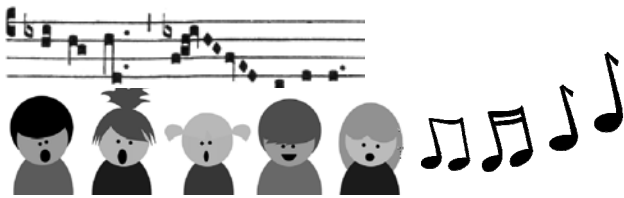

The Ward Method is a comprehensive music education method, developed by Catholic convert Justine Ward in the 1920s. The method has as its goal the education of the child in the beauty of the Church's sacred music, and helping children participate well in the sacred liturgy. The method incorporates ear training so that children are able to both intelligently hear and sing written music at sight, as well as a thorough grounding in musical notation which lends itself to other musical studies. Each student learns to match pitch and sing with good vocal technique. Games which develop composition and improvisation skills are incorporated into each lesson, and students are trained in rhythm and musical dictation. The method is designed so that each activity takes 2-5 minutes and keeps young children engaged.

Distilled Theology is the name given to our young adult group that meets regularly at a local restaurant or pub to hear a talk given by one of the Canons.
